

## 55TH UTAH STATE LEGISLATURE 2004 VOTING RECORD

*The Utah Education Association tracked hundreds of bills during the 2004 Legislative Session. This summary highlights several bills that were voted on in the House and/or Senate that could most dramatically affect public education, or indicate support for public education and/or the UEA. It is important to note that a voting record is but one of several items used to evaluate legislators, and it does not explain why a legislator voted a certain way on a bill. ### House

#### HB 43 (M. Dayton) NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND OPTIONS – **Final Passage in House**

*UEA Position: Support Motion **Passed** House (64/8/3)*

The primary intent of this bill was to send a strong message to Wash. DC regarding the unintended, negative consequences of the NCLB legislation. Many who supported the bill had mixed feelings regarding possible loss of federal funding for public education and were not surprised or disappointed when the bill failed in the Senate.

#### HB 45 (Jones/Mascaro) INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX AMENDMENTS FOR EDUCATION FUNDING – **House Revenue & Tax Committee Vote**

*UEA Position: Support Motion to Recommend **Failed** (6-8-0)*

This bill would have provided \$79m for public education by modifying personal exemptions removing the federal deduction as a state deduction and making the income tax more progressive.

#### HB 108 (M. Newbold) INSURANCE AND RETIREMENT FOR CHARTER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES – **Final Passage in House**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** House (46-26-3)*

This bill allows Charter Schools to opt out of offering state retirement to their employees.

#### HB 115 (M. Philpot) CARSON SMITH SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOLARSHIPS – **Motion to Move to Education Interim for Review**

*UEA Position: Support Motion **Failed** House (31-43-1)*

This motion would have moved this bill to interim for further study.

#### HB 115 S3 (M. Philpot) CARSON SMITH SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOLARSHIPS – **Final Passage in House**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** House (43-29-3)*

This bill provides a voucher for parents with students requiring special education services. It will take revenue from the General Fund that could be used for public schools as well as other urgent priorities. The bill has no limits on income eligibility, meaning taxpayers would subsidize private school education for even the wealthiest of families. It does not require that voucher schools be accredited and their teachers certified by the state or any other professional oversight organization.

#### HB 152 (M. Dillree) CHARTER SCHOOL GOVERNANCE – **House Education Standing Committee Vote**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion to Recommend **Passed** (9-5-1)*

This bill creates a State Charter School Board consisting of seven members appointed by the governor and allows Charter Schools administration separate from that of other public schools including exemption from various state laws and rules of the State Board of Education.

#### HB 223 (K. Morgan) STATE SCHOOL BOARD CANDIDATE SELECTION COMMITTEES – **House Education Standing Committee Vote**

*UEA Position: Support Motion to Recommend **Passed** (11-2-2)*

This bill modifies the number of nominating and recruiting committees that select candidates for membership on the State Board of Education; modifies the membership of the nominating and recruiting committees; and modifies the qualifications used by the nominating and recruiting committees to select State Board of Education member candidates.

HB 230 (M. Styer) PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR EDUCATION – **House (first) 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading**

*UEA Position: Support Motion Passed House (38-37-0)*

The bill would have “frozen” the property tax rate at its current level; thereby, generating approximately \$5m more in property tax next year.

HB 230 (M. Styer) PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR EDUCATION – **2<sup>nd</sup> House Motion to Recall Vote**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion Passed House (38-33-4)*

This bill was recalled by the House after the close 3<sup>rd</sup> reading vote that passed the bill to the Senate.

HB 230 S2 (M. Styer) PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR EDUCATION – **House Final Vote**

*UEA Position: Support Motion Failed House (32-42-1)*

After being recalled, the bill was amended to allow for an inflationary adjustment to be added to the property tax levy, but no longer “freezes” the rate.

HB 271 S1 (J. Ferrin) TUITION TAX CREDITS – **House Judiciary Committee Vote**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion to Recommend Passed (7/5/1)*

This bill was first assigned to House Revenue & Taxation Committee. The sponsor then requested the bill be moved to the House Judiciary Committee where it was more likely to pass.

HB 271 S1 (J. Ferrin) TUITION TAX CREDITS – **Motion to lift first substitute from House Judiciary Standing Committee to House 3<sup>rd</sup> reading**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion Failed House (35-38-2)*

This represented a “proxy” vote on Tuition Tax Credits.

HB 302 (M. Styer) VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS ACT AMENDMENTS – **Motion to Amend Out Language Allowing Public Employee to Make Voluntary PAC Contributions** *UEA Position: Opposed Motion to Recommend Passed (43/28/4)*

In the House Workforce Services and Community and Economic Development Committee, language was amended in to allow public employees to make voluntary political action contributions via payroll deduction if they pay the administrative cost.

SB 185 S1 (T. Hatch) PUBLIC EDUCATION AMENDMENTS – **Final Passage in House**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion Passed House (52-18-5)*

This bill modifies the membership and terms of the nominating and recruiting committee that selects candidates for membership on the State Board of Education; provides definitions; requires the State Board of Education to assist school districts and charter schools to develop and implement competency-based education and the use of gain scores; requires the State Board of Education to develop and use monetary and non-monetary incentives, tools, and rewards; requires documentation verifying the qualifications of a person before a competency-based license to teach may be issued; and delays the implementation of new curriculum and graduation requirements.

NOTE: There were a number of bills that were supported by UEA which passed with near-unanimous support. UEA did not include these in the voting record because of space limitations and because it would not have served to differentiate one legislator from another. Two examples which fall into this category are:

HB 263 (B. King) STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AMENDMENTS

SB 230 (J. Evans) PERFORMANCE PLUS – READING ACHIEVEMENT

## Senate

### HB 43 (M. Dayton) NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND OPTIONS – **Senate Education Committee Vote**

*UEA Position: Support Motion to Recommend **Passed** Senate (6/1/1)*

The primary intent of this bill was to send a strong message to Wash. DC regarding the unintended, negative consequences of the NCLB legislation. Many who supported the bill had mixed feelings regarding possible loss of federal funding for public education and were not surprised or disappointed when the bill failed in the Senate.

### HB 74 (B. Ferry) EXTENSION OF SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR STEEL INDUSTRY – **Final Passage in Senate**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** Senate (20/6/3)*

This exemption was given to Geneva Steele to try to save jobs. Nucor Steel in Plymouth, UT, lobbied and received the exemption, not based on need, but because they were in the same kind of business. Now that Geneva is gone, UEA argued that there was no need to extend a million dollars in sales tax exemptions when revenue for education is so limited.

### HB 108 (M. Newbold) INSURANCE AND RETIREMENT FOR CHARTER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES – **Final Passage in Senate**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** Senate (20/3/6)*

This bill allows Charter Schools to opt out of offering state retirement to their employees.

### HB 115 S3 (M. Philpot) CARSON SMITH SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOLARSHIPS – **Final Passage in Senate**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** Senate (17/8/4)*

(Bill description in House section above)

### HB 152 (M. Dillree) CHARTER SCHOOL GOVERNANCE – **Final Passage in Senate**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** Senate (16-4-9)*

This bill creates a State Charter School Board consisting of seven members appointed by the governor and allows Charter Schools administration separate from that of other public schools including exemptions from various state laws and rules of the State Board of Education.

### HB 223 (K. Morgan) STATE SCHOOL BOARD CANDIDATE SELECTION COMMITTEES – **Senate Education Standing Committee Motion to Table Bill**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion to Recommend **Passed** (5-2-0)*

This bill modifies the number of nominating and recruiting committees that select candidates for membership on the State Board of Education; modifies the membership of the nominating and recruiting committees; and modifies the qualifications used by the nominating and recruiting committees to select State Board of Education member candidates. The five republican senators made it clear they preferred SB 185 (T. Hatch) which creates one statewide committee. Motion to table the bill effectively killed it.

### HB 302 (M. Styler) VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS ACT AMENDMENTS – **Senate 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading Calendar Vote**

*UEA Position: Opposed Motion **Passed** Senate (15/7/7)*

### SB 185 S1 (T. Hatch) PUBLIC EDUCATION AMENDMENTS – **Final Passage in Senate**

*UEA Position: Oppose Motion **Passed** Senate (15-4-10)*

This bill modifies the membership and terms of the nominating and recruiting committee that selects candidates for membership on the State Board of Education; provides definitions; requires the State Board of Education to assist school districts and charter schools to develop and implement: competency-based education; and the use of gain scores; requires the State Board of Education to develop and use monetary and non-monetary incentives, tools, and rewards; requires documentation verifying the qualifications of a person before a competency-based license to teach may be issued; and delays the implementation of new curriculum and graduation requirements.
