UEA 2015 LEGISLATIVE VOTING RECORD SUMMARY

SENATE BILLS

SB 34 S1 (Aaron Osmond)

CHARTER SCHOOL AUTHORIZATION AMENDMENTS

UEA's Position: Oppose

Failed in Senate Education Committee

SB 34 allows a municipal legislative body to authorize a charter school within the municipality's boundaries.

SB 97 S3 (Aaron Osmond)

PROPERTY TAX EQUALIZATION AMENDMENTS

UEA's Position: Support

Passed in the House and Senate

SB 97 increases the basic property tax rate, generating an estimated \$75 million in new money for public education to be distributed through an equalization formula.

SB 104 S5 (Alvin Jackson)

EDUCATION ELECTIONS AND REPORTING AMENDMENTS

UEA's Position: Oppose

Failed in the House; Passed in the Senate; Filed

SB 104 amends provisions of the Election Code to make candidates for, and members of, the State Board of Education subject to partisan election and modifies the reporting requirements of state school board office candidates and officeholders.

SB 204 S2 (Aaron Osmond)

PARENTAL RIGHTS IN PUBLIC EDUCATION AMENDMENTS

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed in the House and Senate

SB 204 requires the State Board to make rules for opting out of state/federal tests and provides parents the right to take students out of school.

SB 235 S2 (Wayne Niederhauser)

EDUCATION MODIFICATIONS

UEA's Position: Oppose

Passed in the House and Senate

SB 235 enacts and amends provisions related to public education by identifying the lowest 3% of schools as determined by school grading and other factors and requires school remediation.
