Utah Public Ed Budget At A Glance

During the 2016 Legislative Session, Utah legislators voted to increase public education funding by 5.8%. Here are a few highlights:



► **Growth** in student enrollment

\$94 million funds the 9,700 new students expected in 2016-17.

► **3%** for ALL students

A 3% WPU increase benefits ALL Utah public school students.



► **13.6%** for CHARTER school students

Charter schools receive the 3% WPU increase, plus \$20 million in targeted funding.



► **Technology** for selected students

A \$15 million technology grant program benefits students in participating schools.



► **Teacher supply** funding

All teachers have access to the \$6 million allocated for classroom supplies.



► **Arts** funding

A \$5.7 million grant program benefits students in participating schools.
